Please take notes and hold your questions until the end in order to allow enough time to present you with as much information as possible in an orderly fashion which will answer many of your questions along the way.

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# Why Are We Here?

We want to inform and educate the entire East Lake Area Community and beyond of FACTS which have been recently discovered that WILL affect everyone of you regardless of whether you live in Tarpon Woods or not. We are pleading for your help to spread the word and help us to stop the proposed redevelopment and destruction of the Tarpon Woods Golf Course and its diverse ecosystem that has existed since the beginning of time by creating both a wetland mitigation bank and the development of approximately 320+ residential units on the property where the current golf course has existed for over 50 years.

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# Brief Summary

- The owners of the Tarpon Woods Golf Course property notified Pinellas County Officials approximately 2 years ago of their intent to close the existing golf course and stated the course is not viable.
  - Plans were submitted to SWFWMD on March 1, 2024 as part of a Conceptual Permit Application to solely create a Wetland Mitigation Bank on the golf course property.
  - They plan on filling almost all of the existing golf course ponds, modifying (destroying) existing wetland conservation areas, and creating new ponds and unestablished wetlands by excavating approx. 262,000 cubic yards of soil which equates to 13,100 20yd dump truck loads
  - Based on a meeting between the developers and the Pinellas County Development Review Committee on July 31, 2024, they plan to build 320+ residential units on the approx. 88.4 acres of newly created upland area as a result of the mitigation bank creation. (Could be single family, multifamily, or apartments)
  - There is no intention or requirement for the developers to improve the existing flooding issues and they "hope" not to make it worse
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# Definitions

**Mitigation Bank:** Mitigation banking is a practice in which an environmental enhancement and preservation project is conducted by a public agency or private entity ("banker") to provide mitigation for unavoidable wetland impacts within a defined region (mitigation service area). The bank is the site itself, and the currency sold by the banker to the impact permittee is a credit, which represents the wetland ecological value equivalent to the complete restoration of one acre. The number of potential credits permitted for the bank and the credit debits required for impact permits are determined by the permitting agencies.

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We learned about plans to destroy Tarpon Woods Golf Course only a few weeks ago, and only by chance. We were not supposed to know this was happening yet. This plan was developed in the dark, and powerful people have been working very hard to keep this under wraps so they could run these plans through the necessary approval processes as far as possible without any public knowledge, interference, or comment, but obviously even rich and powerful people make mistakes. This plan is not without flaws, and its not a done deal.

We need everyone in this room to be up to speed with what we know so we can all leave this room on the same page.

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This meeting will hopefully be beneficial for those of you attending the public meeting at the Tarpon Woods clubhouse this coming Wednesday at 5pm, but this meeting is also for those of you who can't make it. We want everyone in this room tonight to know what's going on and the actions we can take now as residents from our own homes. This project has the potential to affect all of us, not only those of us in Tarpon Woods. We hope that all of you will leave here armed with the knowledge to be able to confidently tell your friends and neighbors who couldn't make it tonight what is happening and why they need to help us fight.

Together we can empower the community with the knowledge you will take away from here; helping you understand what is happening and the actions we need to take. Its going to take the whole village, we need all hands on deck because the only way we win, is if we fight this fight, **TOGETHER!**

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Their proposal is being rolled out in 2 phases. Phase 1 is to get approved by SWFWMD to create man made protected wetlands (aka Wetland Mitigation Bank) on the parts of the course where they cannot build, and in the process, create elevated uplands where they can build in the future.

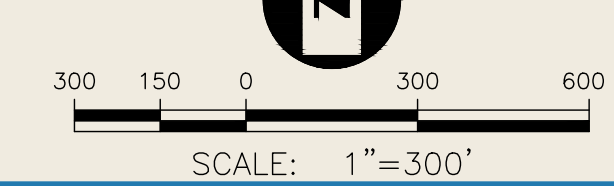
The phase 1 proposal is to fill in the ponds on the golf course and create littoral shelves, excavate the land around the filled ponds to create a marsh, plant wetland vegetation, and fence the ENTIRE area off from the public.

The creation of these wetlands, if approved by SWFWMD, creates the potential to generate "Wetland Mitigation Credits" that can be used by developers to fill in wetland areas later. Those wetlands could be here or anywhere else in the Tampa Bay Area Watershed. We are not just protecting Tarpon Woods, we are protecting the entire Tampa Bay Area.



The creation of uplands will be key to phase 2, which is the development of homes on these newly created uplands. This will be done at the County level after SWFWMD is out of the picture.

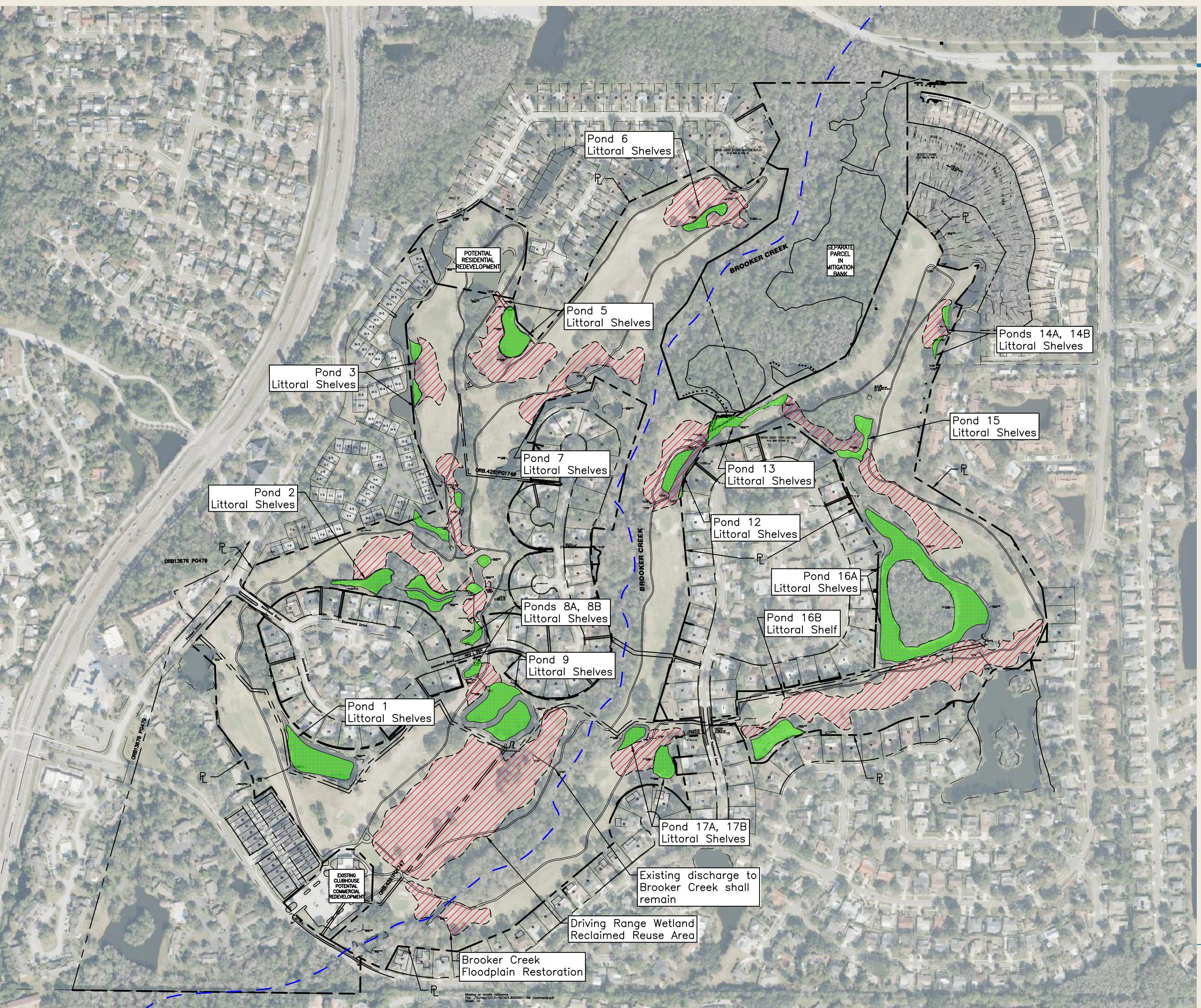

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The maps submitted to the county hint at phase 2 development, and in the meeting with the Pinellas County Development Review Committee, future development plans to build housing were discussed contrary to the application to SWFWMD where they stated that the Wetland Mitigation Bank Permit Application is **not** tied to a larger project.

This is most likely because if they submitted their entire plan to SWFWMD with the additional housing they would get neither SWFWMD's approval nor ours. Our #1 FOCUS RIGHT NOW is stopping this at SWFWMD.

If the Wetland Mitigation Bank Permit gets approval (phase 1), but the project stalls or fails to get approval for phase 2 (Residential Development of 320+ homes), Tarpon Woods Properties LLC could, and most likely will, still destroy the course and still move forward with the Wetland Mitigation Bank project and sleep on it for a period of time and sneak back in when we aren't paying attention and try for Phase 2 again.

They ARE REQUIRED BY SWFWMD to put up a fence at our property lines and human entrance is strictly prohibited by law. It WILL NOT be a nice park that you can enjoy.

These man made wetlands will be protected, they will not be sprayed for mosquitos, our quality of life will become unpleasant, our property values will plummet, and the wonderful wildlife we all have come to love and enjoy will suffer.

The corridor of land that animals use to travel between John Chestnut Park and Brooker Creek Preserve will be destroyed as well as the established structure of ecology.

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If they get approval for phase 2, we will lose the remaining green space to housing developments. Possibly houses, condos, town homes, or 5 story apartments like US HWY 19 is littered with, though most likely a combination of some or all. They ARE planning on moving the 320+ already approved residential permits from the 38 acres of land south of the bridge on Ridgemoor Blvd to the golf course area. Developers have been trying to do this for years. All the prior attempts involved keeping the golf course open and have subsequently failed. This proposal is unique because the developer seeks to close the golf course.

We will endure years of construction; heavy equipment and trucks moving the soil they remove from the course. (262,000 cubic yards of excavation is 13,100 - 20yd dump truck loads. (And that's just for the excavation stage)

Their plans to fill the ponds on the course will eliminate the destinations that Pinellas County uses for the pumps that move storm water to help alleviate existing neighborhood flooding. They have proposed no alternative for improving this, and in their public meeting with the Pinellas County Development Review Committee they expressed that their project will **NOT** improve flooding issues for existing residents, and they will "try" not to make it worse

New roadways will need to be built or widened adding further traffic congestion to the entire area Building more housing will also add another 600+ cars traveling up and down East Lake Road, another roadway that we know is already feeling the strain and at capacity.

We know from the proposal and public response for the Brooker Creek Bridge project that we already are already at capacity for our existing roadways.

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So what can we do? We need to remain calm and cordial when communicating our desire to stop these plans, but most importantly **WE NEED TO BE UNITED** in our desire to **KEEP TARPON WOODS A GOLF COURSE**. I cannot stress this point enough. Any variance in this message plays into the hands of the developers.

Why does this hurt us? We must remember they are only revealing phase 1 and keeping phase 2 in the shadows and away from agencies like SWFWMD to get their foot in the door. They must spin this project as beneficial to the community and beneficial to the environment even though we KNOW nothing could be further from the truth. I suspect they will be painting a wonderful picture of a beautiful nature preserve instead of a toxic environment like a golf course.

Suggesting other land use such as creating a public park or a nature preserve gives our opposition openings to make new arguments and will hurt our cause. This has been proven to be the case in past attempts by other residents around the country who were faced with the same issue. A vote will go out and a “NON UNIFIED” solution will lose to the developer in court.

Our goal is to expose the discrepancies in their documents and meeting conversations. To tell SWFWMD, the Pinellas County Development Review Committee, and the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners all the problems this will cause for our neighborhoods, for our homes, our quality of life, and the existing ENDANGERED WILDLIFE we all have come to love so much who share their neighborhood with us. We have to be their voices too!
